

Sunday School Lesson: Jesus Is King Everywhere

Source essay: `Stop the Atheism Factory.md`

Age: 3-6 years old

Length: 25-35 minutes

Main truth: Jesus is King over every place, so His people shine for Him in the world.

Memory verse: "All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth." - Matthew 28:18, KJV

Teacher's Big Idea

This essay argues that Christ reigns now and His church should not retreat from the world. For children, the lesson becomes joyful and practical: Jesus is King everywhere, so we can obey Him, shine like lights, and do good in His world.

Supplies

- A Bible
- A crown picture
- A globe or simple world picture
- A flashlight
- Coloring supplies
- A city picture

Opening Question

Ask: "Where does Jesus rule?"

Let children answer. Then say: "Today we will learn this truth: Jesus is King over every place, so His people shine for Him in the world."

Bible Time

Hold up the Bible and say: "God's Word tells us the truth about Jesus and His saving work."

"All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth." - Matthew 28:18, KJV

Explain: "Jesus is King over every place, so His people shine for Him in the world."

Repeat-after-me phrase:

"Jesus is King everywhere."

Simple Teaching

1. Jesus Is King Now

Teacher say: "Jesus has all authority right now."

Child repeat: "Jesus is King."

2. Jesus Sends His People

Teacher say: "Jesus tells His people to go and serve Him in the world."

Child repeat: "Go for Jesus."

3. We Shine Like Lights

Teacher say: "We show His love and truth where we live."

Child repeat: "Shine for Jesus."

Object Lesson

Show the crown and globe together and say: "Jesus is not King over one little place only."

Turn on the flashlight and say: "Jesus wants His people to shine."

Point to the city picture and say: "We serve Jesus where people live, learn, and work."

Movement Activity

- "Jesus is King." Lift hands like a crown.
- "Go for Jesus." March in place.
- "Shine for Jesus." Spread fingers like light.
- "Love your neighbor." Open arms wide.
- "Jesus rules everywhere." Point around the room.

Repeat once with the children.

Short Story Illustration

Mia liked using a flashlight in the dark hallway when the power blinked out for a moment.

The small light helped everyone see where to walk.

At church Mia heard that Jesus is King everywhere, and His people are to shine for Him in the world.

Discussion Questions

1. What is the main truth today?

Expected answer: Jesus is King over every place, so His people shine for Him in the world.

2. What should we remember?

Expected answer: Jesus is King everywhere.

3. Who helps God's people?

Expected answer: Jesus.

4. Is God's Word true?

Expected answer: Yes.

5. What should we do?

Expected answer: Trust and obey the Lord.

Craft or Table Activity

Make a paper globe with a small crown above it and write: "Jesus is King everywhere."

Closing Prayer

Our Father in heaven, thank You for Your true Word and for the Lord Jesus Christ. Help us believe Your promises, love what is true, and walk in faith and obedience. In Jesus' name, Amen.
