

# Sunday School Lesson: God Speaks in Scripture and Creation

Source essay: `The Two Books Reading Scripture and Creation Together.md`

**Age:** 3-6 years old

**Length:** 25-35 minutes

**Main truth:** God shows His glory in Scripture and in the world He made.

**Memory verse:** "The heavens declare the glory of God." - Psalm 19:1, KJV

## Teacher's Big Idea

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This essay explains the two-books pattern of reading Scripture and creation together. For children, keep it simple and worshipful: God gave us the Bible, God made the world, and both help us praise Him rightly.

## Supplies

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- A Bible
- A sky picture
- A flower picture
- A sun picture
- Coloring supplies
- A magnifying glass

## Opening Question

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Ask: "What are some things outside that remind you of God?"

Let children answer. Then say: "Today we will learn this truth: God shows His glory in Scripture and in the world He made."

## Bible Time

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Hold up the Bible and say: "God's Word tells us the truth about Jesus and His saving work."

"The heavens declare the glory of God." - Psalm 19:1, KJV

Explain: "God shows His glory in Scripture and in the world He made."

Repeat-after-me phrase:

"God speaks and God made."

## Simple Teaching

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### 1. God Gave Us His Word

Teacher say: "The Bible tells us God's truth."

Child repeat: "God's Word is true."

### 2. God Made the World

Teacher say: "Creation shows God's power and glory."

Child repeat: "God made the world."

### 3. Both Lead Us to Praise

Teacher say: "We should thank God for His Word and His works."

Child repeat: "Praise the Lord."

## Object Lesson

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Show the Bible first and say: "God speaks clearly in His Word."

Then show the sky and flower pictures and say: "God's world shows His glory too."

Use the magnifying glass to look at a leaf or picture detail and say: "God made His world with wisdom."

## Movement Activity

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- "God's Word is true." Hold hands open like a book.
- "God made the world." Stretch arms wide.
- "Praise the Lord." Lift hands upward.
- "Look at God's works." Shade eyes with hand.
- "Thank You, God." Place hands on heart.

Repeat once with the children.

## Short Story Illustration

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Lydia liked looking closely at flowers in the yard with a magnifying glass.

Then she came inside and opened her Bible with her mother.

At church Lydia learned that God shows His glory in the world He made and in the Word He gave.

## Discussion Questions

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1. What is the main truth today?

Expected answer: God shows His glory in Scripture and in the world He made.

2. What should we remember?

Expected answer: God speaks and God made.

3. Who helps God's people?

Expected answer: Jesus.

4. Is God's Word true?

Expected answer: Yes.

5. What should we do?

Expected answer: Trust and obey the Lord.

## Craft or Table Activity

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Draw a Bible on one side of the page and a sky with flowers on the other. Write: "Praise the Lord."

## Closing Prayer

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Our Father in heaven, thank You for Your true Word and for the Lord Jesus Christ. Help us believe Your promises, love what is true, and walk in faith and obedience. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Parent Take-Home Line

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God shows His glory in Scripture and in the world He made.
